

#### CITANZ - Home for all Chinese IT professionals in New Zealand

Dear CITANZ Members and Supporters,

As President of CITANZ, I am pleased to share our remarkable achievements and growth over the 2023-2024 period.

Our organization has made significant strides in fulfilling our mission of fostering professional development for Chinese IT professionals across New Zealand.

#### **Key Achievements**

This year has been marked by exceptional growth across all metrics. Our active membership increased by 27.9% to 293 members. Our digital presence has expanded substantially, with LinkedIn followers growing by 39.9% to 1,447, Meetup followers increasing by 41.4% to 1,656, and YouTube subscribers reaching 402 with a 28.4% growth.

#### **Community Engagement**

We significantly enhanced our community engagement by:

- Organizing 27 meet-up events across our three branches, showing a 68.7% increase from the previous year
- Hosting 12 social events, demonstrating our commitment to building stronger connections
- Successfully launching the 2024 Mentorship programme with 36 mentees and 18 mentors

#### **Financial Performance**

Our financial position remains strong with:

- Total revenue of \$24,143.56
- Membership fees contributing \$11,337
- Sponsorship revenue of \$2,500

#### **Regional Growth**

We've strengthened our presence across New Zealand through our three operational branches in Wellington (HQ), Christchurch, and Auckland. Each branch has shown remarkable growth, with Auckland notably increasing its membership by 52.05%.

As we look ahead to the 2024/2025 year, our focus remains on improving services and delivering an enhanced experience for our members. We aspire to grow our membership to over 300, secure three active sponsors, and increase our operational revenue to \$20,000 NZD. ## Mentorship Programme 2024



### MENTORSHIP 2024 Key staff: Kelly / Alice



In March 2024, we kicked off our third mentorship program with a big group of mentorship volunteers enrolled to support better engagement in the program.

Our program is structured to unfold in several stages: registration, initial pairing, ongoing mentoring, and program closure.

This year, we had a total of <u>36</u> mentees and <u>18</u> mentors registering. We successfully paired up 6 one-on-one mentoring pairs, and formed 5 mentoring circles. Each mentoring circle was supported by two volunteers to be the host and co-host.

These circles focus on diverse topics, including career development, job hunting strategies for experienced professionals, and job hunting guidance for recent graduates. The mentorship program has garnered a warm reception within the community, with over 75% of the groups having more than 4 meetings during the 4-month program. Great connections have been formed in those circles and very positive feedback has been received.

The mentorship program will kick off in March 2025. Stay tuned!



Over the past year, we organized a diverse range of tech-focused meetup events, bringing together IT enthusiasts, professionals, and experts from various domains in three major branches.
