Dear CITANZ Members, Supporters, and Friends,
I am thrilled to present to you the remarkable highlights of CITANZ for the year 2022-2023. Over the past year, our organisation has achieved substantial growth and success, thanks to the dedication and support of our members, volunteers, and partners.
 Membership Growth: Our membership has surged by an impressive 42.5%, from 160 members in 2022 to a total of 228 members in 2023. This growth demonstrates the increasing strength of our community.
 Job Opportunities: We have continued to provide valuable job opportunities to our members, with 60 new jobs created in 2023, building on the success of previous years.
 Financial Health: Our financial position remains robust. In the 2022-2023 financial period, our operation revenue reached \$11,239.16, reflecting steady growth from previous years. Our financial report for the period from July 2022 to June 2023 shows responsible financial management, with a total revenue of \$11,239.16 and total expenses of \$16,003.70.
 LinkedIn and Meetup Presence: Our presence on social media platforms has seen significant growth. On LinkedIn, we have witnessed a remarkable increase of 51.9%, reaching 1,030 followers by September 2023. Similarly, our Meetup followers have grown by 27%, totalling 1,171 members. Our YouTube channel has experienced an impressive 71% growth, reaching 313 followers. This achievement highlights our commitment to providing valuable content to our members.



MENTORSHIP PROGRAMME

In February 2023, we kicked off our second mentorship program with some exciting updates to our mentorship processes. This time around, we introduced a fresh mentoring format known as "mentoring circles."

Our program is structured to unfold in several stages: registration, initial pairing, ongoing mentoring, and program closure.


This year, we witnessed a significant surge in participation, with a total of 43 mentees and 25 mentors registering—a doubling of our numbers compared to last year. We successfully paired up 15 one-on-one mentoring pairs, and additionally, we formed 3 mentoring circles.



These circles focus on diverse topics, including career development, job hunting strategies for experienced professionals, and job hunting guidance for recent graduates. The mentorship program has garnered a warm reception within the community, with over 90% of mentees expressing high levels of satisfaction, ranging from very satisfied to extremely satisfied with our program.

The program received positive feedback from mentors and mentees.

I would also like to extend a sincere thank you to Karen for her outstanding organizational skills in creating a comfortable and relaxed environment for all our mentoring events where we could freely network and offer assistance to one another. I genuinely hope that we will have more opportunities for career-related exchanges in the future, as these interactions have been invaluable for our professional growth and development.






