Mentorship Programme Business Development Membership v2.0



MENTORSHIP PROGRAMME

We kicked off our first mentorship programme in June 2022, with the mentorship process and resources publicly shared with our membership group. The program is designed to be carried out in multiple steps: registration, initial matching, mentoring in progress and program closure.

> **Registration phase** During July 1st - 17th, the programme attracted 19 mentees and 10 mentors.

Initial matching phase


During 17th July to the first week of August, we analysed the registration data and managed to connect the mentees and mentors to organise their first meetings. We successfully set up 12 mentor/mentee matching groups.

Engagement phase

From August to October, the matching groups are doing their self-organised meetings, with the support from CITA

The program has received very positive feedback from both mentors and mentees.
